Donations for any food taken will also be collected and sent to support CAFOD's projects overseas.

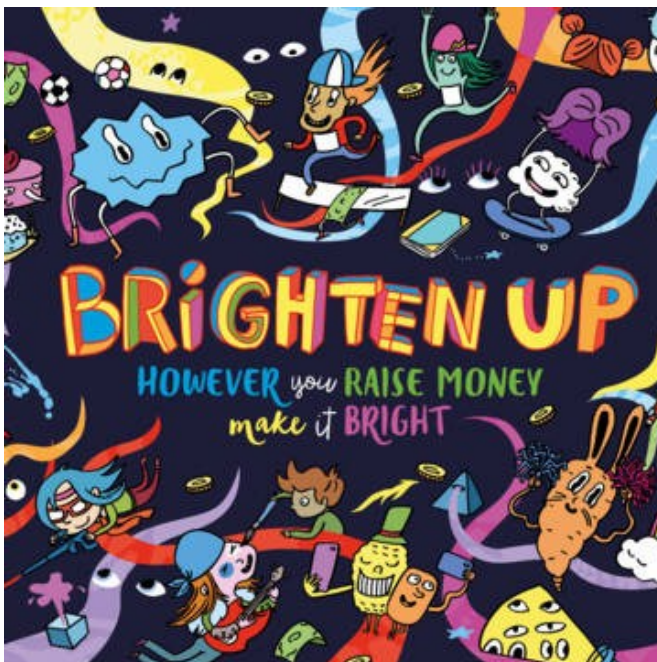
